Subject: Introduction of a feedback form bunkering of conventional fuels

The Director of the Central Nautical Management North Sea Canal Area, who is also the (State) Harbour Master, announces the following:

Bunkering permit for residual fuels

At the moment, in the Amsterdam North Sea Canal Area residual fuels, distillates and blends thereof, such as fuel oil and marine diesel oil, are not subject to a permit requirement for the bunker operators, which means that the existing situation continues for the time being. A reconsideration will take place at the end of 2021 as to whether there will be a permit requirement for these fuels, following the example of the Rotterdam-Rijnmond region.

Feedback in case of incidents

The feedback form can be used by any stakeholder involved in case an incident occurs during the bunkering of conventional fuels. The input is part in the evaluation of the bunker permit for transporters, if such a permit should be introduced in this area.
