

Decree No. 2023/46

<u>Subject:</u> Traffic Decree of the Director of the Central Nautical Management (*CNB*) to impose a a prohibition to shipping traffic to enter a work area located in the Afgesloten IJ near De Ruijterkade Oost

The Director of the Central Nautical Management North Sea Canal Area,

Having regard to:

- Articles 3, 4, 5, and 7 of the Shipping Traffic Act as well as Annex 7 of the Inland Navigation Police Regulations (BPR);
- The Decree of the Mayor and Aldermen, dated 3 December 2019 (published in the Municipal Gazette on 3 January 2020 and available on the Port of Amsterdam website) in which the Director of the Central Nautical Management North Sea Canal Area has been given a mandate to adopt Decrees relevant to this Decree.

Whereas:

- In the area located in the Afgesloten IJ near De Ruijterkade Oost, activities will take place from 06 November 2023 to 14 December 2023 in connection with the renovation of jetty pontoons and the construction of berths for canal cruise boats.
- The designated areas will only be accessible to ships which have to carry out activities for the infrastructure works mentioned above.
- In the period from 01 November 2023 to 14 December 2023 berth RO1 will be out of use.
- During the period 01 November 2023 to 01 March 2024, berths RO2, RO3 and RO4 will be out of use.

Has decreed the following:

- To designate the area of the Afgesloten IJ located near De Ruijterkade Oost as a work area (see overview maps of the work area) for the period from 06 November, 00.00 LT to 20 December 2023, 24.00 LT, or on such earlier date as the activities will be completed.
- 2. Special (yellow) buoys with top mark A1, in accordance Annex 7 of the Inland Navigation Police Regulations (*BPR*), indicate the boundary of the work area.
- 3. During the period mentioned under 1, the designated work area is only accessible to ships which have to carry out activities for the infrastructure works mentioned above. The designated work area is closed for other shipping traffic.

4. For the purpose of the activities, a prohibition on causing nuisance due to excessive wash or suction is put in place. This is indicated by prohibition sign A.9 in accordance with Annex 7 of the Inland Navigation Police Regulations (*BPR*).


Explanation:

This Traffic Decree is an elaboration to prevent ships from running aground and to protect the construction activities near De Ruijterkade Oost. To prevent users of the fairway from entering the area, the area will be safely demarcated by special (yellow) buoys with top mark A1, in accordance with Annex 7 of the Inland Navigation Police Regulations (BPR).

This will prevent users of the fairway from entering the work area which might cause damage to their ship or damage to the activities carried out in this area
