

Shore leave in the Port of Amsterdam



Notice to Seafarers

Port of Amsterdam, in cooperation with the boatsmen of the Koperen Ploeg, provides **one free return trip per vessel call** for seafarers on vessels moored at public locations without direct shore access. And Cargill also provides a free return trip at its terminal locations.

Who can use this service?

- All crew on vessels moored at public port assets without a direct connection to land.

How to request transport?

- The ship's agent submits the request to the boatsmen of Koperen Ploeg.
- Crew may contact Koperen Ploeg directly if familiar with the procedure.
- Koperen Ploeg will confirm booking and pick-up time.

Respect shoreleave rights

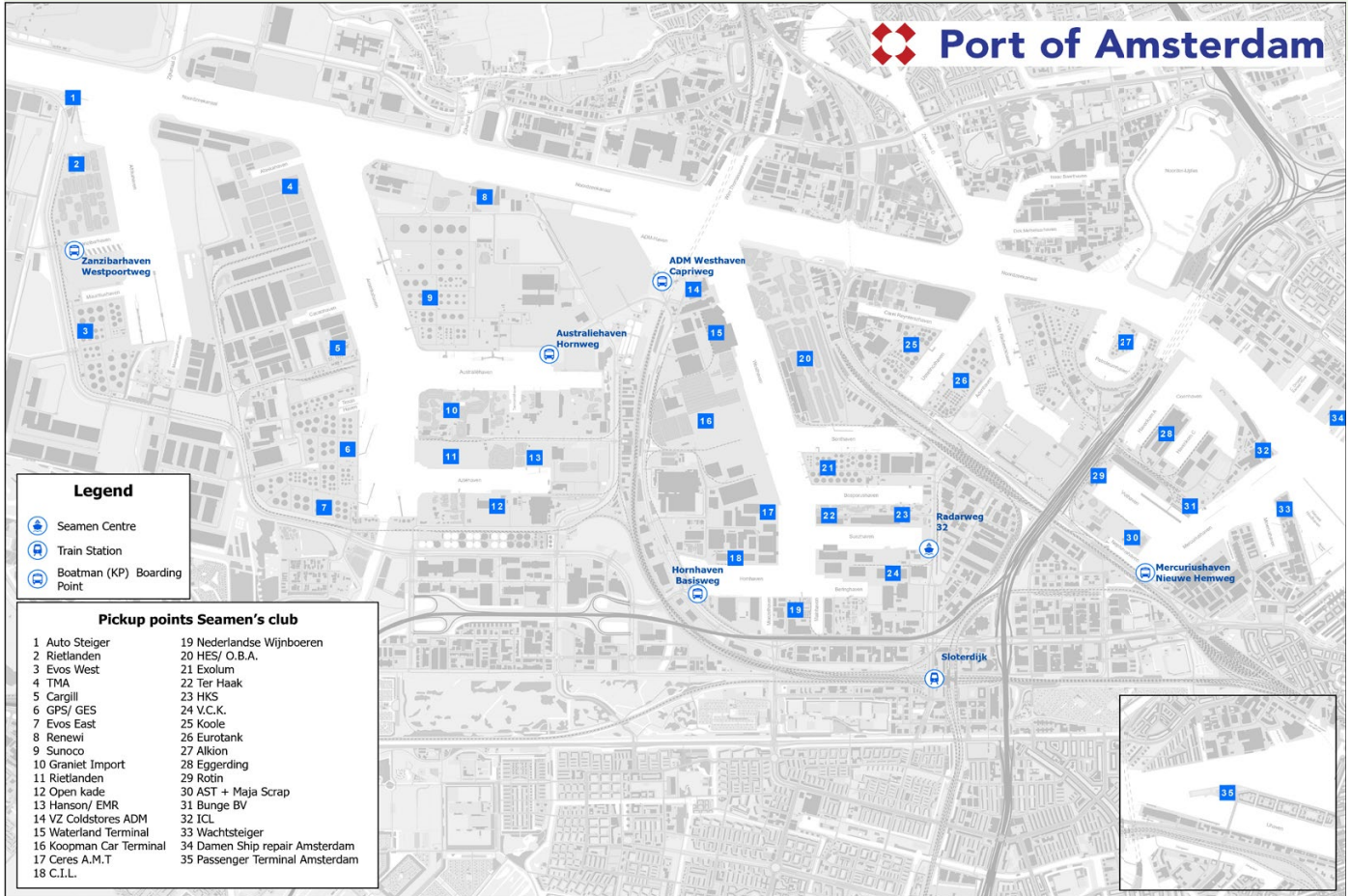
- Security should not impose unnecessary restrictions.
