Subject: works at kmp 8, south bank North Sea Canal

The Director of the Central Nautical Management North Sea Canal Area, who is also the (State) Harbour Master, announces the following:

The following work will be carried out for the installation of a measuring structure at the existing jetty at kilometre marker 8 on the south side of the North Sea Canal:

Assisting / adapting existing measuring structure to existing scaffolding

- Week 41 / Mon 05-10-2026 / 07:00-17:00 /

Modification of the existing measurement construction carried out with pile driver de Noord.

Applying measurement construction phase 1

- Week 41 / Tue 06-10-2026 / 07:00-17:00 /

The installation of the measuring construction, positioning the measuring sensor and connecting the casing pipe was carried out underwater (diving work). The work will be carried out from the work vessel the Noord.

Applying measurement construction phase 2

- Week 41 / Wed 07-10-2026 / 07:00-17:00

Installing the measuring construction casing pipe and assembling underwater (diving work) and mounting the other side to existing jetty. Work will be carried out from the work vessel the Noord.

Reserve Day

- Week 41 / Thu 08-10-2026 / Fri 09-10-2026 / 07:00-17:00 / Possible overrun works

The workboats involved in this project are on standby on the VHF block channel in question and show the prescribed lighting and signalling in accordance with the BPR.

-Consequences for shipping :

- The work vessel the Noord (length 55 m) moors l/z the jetty, on site the available passage width on the North Sea Canal will be 223 m

- Prevention of annoying wave movement

-Obligation for shipping to pay extra attention to these activities.
